- All Junior Board members must attend one additional volunteer event in addition to the flagship volunteer event hosted by the Junior Board each year.
- Each Junior Board member is responsible for contributing (*via fundraising or personal contribution*) \$100 per year.
- A full commitment to attending meetings and participating in events hosted by Brighton Center or the Junior Board. The Junior Board meets monthly and committees meet quarterly.
